

INFORMATION FOR THE JLPT PARTICIPANTS

Please note: all participants will be sent an e-mail containing voucher downloading instruction, exam schedule, venue address and other important information no later than 10 days prior to the exam. In case you did not receive it, please contact SPbU Language Testing Center by the e-mail jlpt@spbu.ru or by phone +7 (812) 325 11 24.

What to bring on test day:

- identification document with a photo;
- printed voucher;
- HB pencil;
- eraser.

REGULATIONS FOR THE JLPT

1. Participants are allowed to enter the building **45 minutes prior to the start of the exam**. We kindly ask you to arrive in advance. Latecomers are allowed to enter the test room during the first 10 minutes of the following sections:

- for N1 and N2 – Language Knowledge (Vocabulary/Grammar) & Reading
- for N3, N4 and N5 – Language Knowledge (Vocabulary); Language Knowledge (Grammar) & Reading

Please note that **no examinee can be admitted** for any reason after the CD has been started during the Listening section.

2. Participants must take their designated seats in the test room **strictly** according to their registration number, which is provided in the test voucher. Each seat will be marked with the last 5 digits of the registration number.

3. During the test, the examinees should place on their desks only:

- writing materials (pencils and erasers);
- a watch (digital watches are prohibited);
- the test voucher (face side up).

No other materials such as textbooks, dictionaries, mobile phones or notes may be used. Before the start of the exam **mobile phones must be switched off** and left in the designated place alongside the other personal belongings **until the end of the entire exam session**.



MISCONDUCT

Examinees who have attempted to commit or have committed any of the misconduct listed below will be **disqualified** from the test and will have their test results **invalidated**:

- using mobile phones or other devices with photographing and communicating functions, including during breaks (in case of an urgent need to use a mobile phone an examinee must obtain permission from proctor or any staff member);
- talking during the test, providing others with answers or obtaining answers from other examinees; using a dictionary, textbook, reference book, crib sheet, earphone; writing answers in advance on the desk or writing equipment;
- taking the test with someone else's ID or using a fraudulent ID;
- refusing to follow the proctor's instructions;
- taking the question booklets and/or answer sheets outside the test room; taking photos of or copying the question booklets and/or answer sheets; making public any test content (including any of the recording from the CDs used in the Listening section) over the Internet or any other communication network;
- disturbing other examinees in any way;
- cooperating with someone committing misconduct listed above.

* An examinee whose mobile phone or watch sounds or vibrates during the test will also be considered to have committed **misconduct**. The examinee will be disqualified from the test and their test results will be invalidated.

Please keep in mind: it is strictly forbidden to make public any test content (answer sheets, test questions and answers to them, any recordings from the CDs used in the Listening section) over the Internet or any other communication network. Anyone who commits or cooperates with any of the above actions will have his or her test results **retroactively invalidated**.
